Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Much of Scotland, the north of England and also the far east of England, may be rather wet at times today with some rain which could be heavy in places. Elsewhere, it'll be drier but often fairly cloudy still. Best of the brighter spells in the far south. Breezy.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Risk of a few showers spreading south on Sunday, but these should ease later with most places seeing some sunshine. Generally dry and bright with some sunshine after a cold start on Monday but turning cloudier in the northwest later with some rain following.
