

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 1945 on Tuesday 10 Aug 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Rain over much of Scotland at times through the day, turning heavy in places.  
Mainly dry with patchy cloud and some decent sunny intervals elsewhere, though scattered showers are likely in northern England and Wales and Northern Ireland. Temperatures generally near normal for this time of year, but slightly cooler in Scotland.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Rain or showers in many northern and eastern areas of the UK on Thursday, but generally drier and brighter in the south and west. Friday will see the showers become mostly confined to central and eastern England, while most other places stay dry but often rather cloudy.
