Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Dry and fine once again for most, with light winds and some warm sunny spells giving temperatures similar to Saturday. Northern Ireland and western Scotland will be breezier and rather cloudy with a little rain and drizzle, especially later on. England and Wales should stay dry overnight, while Northern Ireland and Scotland should remain rather cloudy with some patchy rain.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
Remaining largely fine to start the working week, especially in the south and east of the UK. The odd sharp shower may develop in the cloudier north and west, with these becoming prolonged very locally given the generally light winds.
