

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Largely dry with plenty of sunshine. A few showers are likely to develop, mainly across Scotland and Northern Ireland, perhaps locally frequent and heavy. Feeling warm, particularly in the southeast, though breezy in the north. Clear spells and light winds for many overnight, allowing patchy mist, but cloudier over some southeastern parts. Isolated showers will continue in the far northwest.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Often unsettled with sunshine and showers. More persistent rain is likely across the south and east on Friday, turning heavy at times and spreading northeastwards, then clearing the east early on Saturday. Becoming breezy around some coasts. Generally feeling warm.
