Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most parts of United Kingdom will be dry and bright before cloud and rain spreads into the north and west later in the day, with some sleet or snow likely on high ground. Generally cloudy overnight with further rain at times, and some sleet or snow in the far north. Becoming drier and clearer over Scotland towards dawn.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Rain clears from all but the southwest on Tuesday, with wintry showers expected in Scotland and northeastern England. Further rain spreads from the southwest on Wednesday, falling as sleet or snow on high ground and possibly at lower levels in the north.
