Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Much of England and Wales seeing a few hours of heavy, persistent and sometimes squally rain, this starting in northwest England and Wales and working its way south and east, with southeast England staying dry until after dark. Northern Ireland and Scotland generally brighter, with scattered heavy, thundery showers. Most places windy, with gales around western coasts and hills.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Staying unsettled across the United Kingdom through the rest of the working week, with further showers or longer spells of rain for many places and the best chance of sunny spells in the east. Often windy and generally feeling rather cold.
