Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
It will be a dry and cold day with most areas having some sunshine. However, patches of mist or fog and areas of low cloud will be slow to disperse from some locations, especially in parts of central and eastern England. It will remain frosty all day in places.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:  
Remaining cold as we head into the New Year, although it will tend to become cloudier, especially in the east. New Year's Eve will be mainly dry but there will be a few wintry showers in eastern and northern areas on New Year's Day.
