Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Bright but cold across Scotland this morning with blustery showers in the north. Much cloudier elsewhere with a little rain and drizzle in places, although clearer, colder weather will spread south across the UK during the day and overnight. Most areas will be dry, clear and cold tonight, although with increasingly wintry showers extending down the east coast. Staying windy.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
Largely fine and dry across much of Britain with a good deal of sunshine. There is the risk of scattered showers, mainly towards eastern coasts, which will turn increasingly to snow. Staying cold with widespread frost and freezing fog patches.
