

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Sunday 01 Feb 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Showers across northern Scotland and Northern Ireland, giving some snow, easing overnight. Some wintry showers also across parts of eastern England, clearing later. Dry and sunny elsewhere, then clear spells overnight, and winds easing across the UK. Parts of Wales and southern England seeing a slight covering of snow at first. Very cold with frost and icy patches.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Starting cold with icy patches, then mostly dry with sunny spells on Monday. Becoming windy with band of rain, sleet and snow moving south into Scotland in the afternoon. This continuing south overnight and through Tuesday, with further showers moving into northeast.
