

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Friday 03 Aug 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Starting mainly dry with sunny spells, later joined by scattered showers.
Western UK will be cloudier, with more prolonged spells of rain edging eastward
from Northern Ireland, increasingly affecting parts of breezy western Britain
later. Overnight, much of the UK will become dry as showers ease, however more
persistent rain over western areas will gradually move into central parts.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

The weekend should see further sunny spells, but also some heavy and locally
thunderly showers, while the south should also remain breezy. The showers will be
heaviest over western and later central parts, perhaps forming bands of more
prolonged rain.
