

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Northern Ireland, much of mainland Scotland and northern England will be dry with some sunshine. Wales and southern England will stay warm, albeit cloudier than of late with isolated showers. Meanwhile, wet and windy weather will arrive across northern Scotland, which will sink southeastwards overnight.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Rain will affect parts of central Scotland and Northern Ireland on Sunday. Much of England and Wales rather cloudy at first, but with sunny spells developing and perhaps a few isolated showers. Perhaps some early thunderstorms in the far southeast on Monday, with sunshine and showers developing elsewhere. Still warm and humid in the south.
