

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Friday 19 Sep 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloud will linger across northwestern parts of Scotland, Northern Ireland and Cumbria, bringing occasional light rain and drizzle, today and also overnight. Remaining areas mostly dry, after a few early spots of light rain across southern England, with sunny spells developing today. Overnight clear spells will allow patchy mist and fog to form, especially across south Wales and western England.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Saturday and Sunday outbreaks of light rain and low cloud across the far northwest of Scotland. Elsewhere dry both for days, and becoming sunny in many places, once early mist and patchy fog clears. Feeling pleasantly warm, with light winds.
