

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Monday 07 May 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain will spread northeastwards across the UK today, with sunny spells and showers then following for many. However, further persistent rain will mainly affect parts of Wales and western England, coupled with brisk winds. Overnight, most will see some rain, with this rain heaviest in southwestern England and south Wales, and later northeastern Scotland.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

On both days northern Scotland will be mainly cloudy and wet, with the southeastern third of the UK similarly cloudy with occasionally heavy spells of rain. Between these two areas, drier and brighter conditions will prevail for many, with sunny spells coupled with a few showers.
