

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
There will be a few snow flurries in Scotland, but most of Northern Ireland and northern England will be dry and bright. Increasingly heavy rain in southern areas will edge steadily northwards into southern and central Wales and the Midlands. Tonight, a spell of snow across much of Wales and the Midlands. Heavy rain further south may cause localised flooding.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:  
Tuesday, rain and snow will clear away eastwards from central and eastern England. Drier, brighter conditions will follow from the west, although there will be wintry showers in Scotland. Wednesday, mostly dry and bright, but wintry showers in the east.
