


# National Severe Weather Warning Service



## CANCELLED

### Chief Forecasters Assessment

There is good confidence that there will be a deep area of low pressure close to the north of the country, but there remains uncertainty regarding the position and strength of the swathe of strongest winds. Latest indications are that the risk extends as far north as central Scotland. Gusts of 70 mph or greater remain a real possibility.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Alert of Wind**

Valid from **11:00 on Tue, 13th Dec 2011** until **23:59 on Tue, 13th Dec 2011**

Another spell of very windy weather is likely to develop later on Tuesday. Westerly winds are likely to gust to severe gale or storm force in places.

The public is advised to monitor this warning, which may be revised.
