Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Mostly cloudy with occasional light rain across England and Wales today. Dry with sunny spells for Scotland, N.Ireland and later Wales and north and west England. Much cooler than recently in the southeast. Patchy rain across Scotland and N.Ireland later today and tonight. Elsewhere, mainly dry, clear and rather chilly overnight.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Patchy rain will push south across central Britain during Thursday. To the north, sunny spells and showers are expected, whilst further south will be mostly dry, but cloudy. Mainly dry and rather breezy with broken cloud and some sunny spells on Friday, just isolated, light showers. Temperatures around normal.
