

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rather cloudy for many with light rain in southern Scotland and northern England moving south into Wales and southeastern England by late afternoon, and into southwest England overnight. Drier further north, with sunny spells developing. Clear spells overnight will give some frost, which should be most widespread in the north and west.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

A largely dry, although rather cold few days for most. Variable amounts of cloud will give some sunny spells, with sunshine all day in some southern areas on Monday. Clear spells overnight will lead to sharp frosts and patchy fog. Northwest Scotland will be cloudier, with some drizzle.
