Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Much of England and Wales will start dry but heavy showers may affect Southwest Wales at first. Scotland and Northern Ireland will start rather cloudy with some outbreaks of light rain in places. Many parts will then have a dry and warm day with spells of hazy sunshine. However, some heavy afternoon showers are likely to break out.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Warm weather will continue with spells of sunshine. Most parts should stay dry but isolated heavy afternoon showers may crop up in the north and west on Sunday, and the northwest of Monday. Northeast coasts may be cool and misty at times.
