

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Sunday 11 Mar 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloudy near exposed western coasts, with areas of hill fog and occasional drizzle. Otherwise most parts will become warm in sunny spells, with the best of these in eastern UK. Overnight it will remain rather cloudy in western areas, with occasional drizzle. Clearer skies in some eastern parts may give chilly conditions locally with some mist and fog patches.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Rather cloudy in the exposed west into the new working week, with northwestern parts perhaps seeing light drizzle at times. Otherwise most parts will be dry throughout, with the cloud breaking and mist clearing to allow further warm sunny spells.
