Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Drizzly rain in Shetland, E.Anglia and SE.England slowly dying out.
Cloudy, mild and mostly dry elsewhere, with eastern and central
districts east of high ground becoming brighter, perhaps seeing a
little sunshine. Cloud thickening in the northwest later, rain then
spreading to all parts except southeast England overnight, with a
freshening southwesterly wind.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Rain clearing Northern Ireland and Scotland on Thursday, followed by
sunny intervals and showers, while England and Wales remain cloudy
with outbreaks of rain. Further rain spreading from west on Friday,
followed by showers in Northern Ireland and western Scotland. Windy
and colder later in the north.
