Headline:

Rain clearing the southeast tomorrow morning, then squally showers.

This Evening and Tonight:

Rain spreading east will linger over southeast England, but elsewhere will be followed by clearer, showery conditions. Windy with gales in north, locally severe.

Rain over southeast England clearing during the morning, then sunny spells and squally showers.

Outlook for Monday:

Wet and windy in the south, and becoming stormy for a time in the far south, but remaining cool and showery elsewhere.
