




Yellow warning
Wind

A widely very windy period expected Monday with some disruption to travel likely.

What to expect

- Some delays to road, rail, air and ferry transport expected, particularly for high-sided vehicles on exposed routes and bridges
- Some bus and train services affected, with some journeys taking longer
- Coastal routes, sea fronts and coastal communities affected by spray and/or large waves
- Some short term loss of power and other services

Further details

An area of very strong winds will move eastwards across the UK through Monday, clearing eastwards overnight.

The strongest winds are expected around exposed coasts and hills. Here gusts of 60-70 mph are likely, with a few sites perhaps seeing gusts to 80 mph - especially around Irish Sea coasts and around the west coast of Scotland where the strongest winds are most likely. Gusts will be lower inland with 45-55 mph likely.
