Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
It will a murky start for many, with areas of locally dense mist and fog having formed overnight, mainly across central and eastern parts. These will gradually clear during the morning, leaving a dry day for the whole UK, with most and especially the west, seeing plenty of warm, if rather hazy sunshine.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Both days will be dry, with most seeing warm sunny spells by day. It will become chilly overnight, with areas of fog and perhaps localised frosts. It will be cloudier and cooler towards eastern coasts of Britain, although eastern Scotland may improve into the new week.
