

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Saturday 02 Apr 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A wet and windy start across Scotland and parts of Northern Ireland, the rain clearing to blustery showers through the morning. Further south, rain will move west to east across the country, locally heavy at first, with sunny periods before and after allowing temperatures to rise. Overnight, most places should be dry, with a few showers continuing north and west.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Showers for many places on Sunday, some of them on the heavy side, but most areas becoming dry and sunny later. Turning cold overnight, with local frost, then further rain spreading to central and northern areas on Monday. Staying windy.
