

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain and sleet will become confined to southeastern England, where it will feel cold in strong northwesterly winds. Elsewhere, a frosty start and then largely dry with sunny spells. Scattered showers in the west will die out in the evening leaving most of the UK cold and frosty overnight. Rain and strong winds across southeast England will gradually ease.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Rain will clear southeastern England early on Tuesday afternoon with a largely fine day elsewhere. However, more unsettled, wet and windy weather will work its way across Scotland and Northern Ireland, spreading across the rest of the UK during Wednesday.
