

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Thursday 11 Feb 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Snow showers at first over southeastern England, most frequent in the far southeast, dying out during the day. Most other parts dry and often sunny, with cloud increasing overnight. Patchy rain and sleet north and east Scotland spreading into northeast England this afternoon and thence to other parts of England overnight, turning to snow in places.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Mostly cloudy on Friday, with some brighter spells in the north and west. Occasional light rain or drizzle for parts of England and Wales, elsewhere remaining generally dry. On Saturday, staying cloudy for most places, with occasional showers in the north and east.
