Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
England and Wales will be largely dry, sunny and warm whilst Scotland and Northern Ireland will be cloudier, although still with some decent sunny periods. Showers, some heavy, are expected in the west this morning, and across central and northern parts this afternoon. Some showers will continue into the night but most places will become dry. Remaining warm.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

On Saturday, the mixture of sunny spells and occasionally heavy showers will continue. Showers are likely to become more frequent on Sunday with less in the way of sunshine. Temperatures should become nearer normal, with winds remaining light and changeable.
