Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain, heavy and persistent at times across Scotland, will slowly extend southeastwards into northern England and Wales during the day. Northern Ireland will see heavy, possibly thundery showers. The rest of England should be dry with some warm sunshine, once any morning mist or fog clears.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Spells of rain or showers, heavy at times, for much of the UK on Thursday, and becoming quite windy in northwest Scotland. Rain will become confined to eastern England by Friday, with many other places becoming largely dry. Turning much cooler everywhere, with a strong north to northeasterly wind setting in.
