


 Yellow warning

What to expect

- Spray and flooding on roads probably making journey times longer
- Bus and train services probably affected with journey times taking longer
- Flooding of a few homes and businesses is likely
- Some interruption to power supplies and other services likely


Further details

A band of rain will move eastwards through Wednesday morning, clearing during the afternoon.

This will bring widely 20-30 mm of rain with spots of 40-50 mm, mainly over the high ground of south Wales and Dartmoor.
