

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Most places will be dry with spells of sunshine, though southeastern areas may be cloudier at times. Cloud and rain spreading across Northern Ireland will reach western Scotland later. It will feel warm in sunshine and light winds. Tonight, most places will remain dry. Northwestern areas will however, have a little rain.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

On Friday, northwestern areas will have a little rain. Elsewhere, it will be mostly dry with sunny spells, but with a few showers in the west. Southeastern areas will remain dry on Saturday, but some rain, perhaps heavy, will spread to the northwest. It will be generally warm.
