Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Southern Scotland and parts of Northern Ireland will have periods of rain, this possibly torrential at times. Elsewhere will see some sunny spells and scattered showers, some of these heavy and possibly thundery, although the south-east the driest. Rain continuing in the north overnight, although spreading across northern England. Elsewhere becoming drier with clear spells.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Sunny intervals and showers for many Friday, some of the showers heavy. Some northern parts will have more general cloud and outbreaks of rain. Similar Saturday with most places seeing a mixture of sunny spells and scattered showers. Becoming drier and brighter from the west.
