Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Persistent and occasionally heavy rain will affect across northern and central parts of the UK, with strong west to southwesterly winds. A risk of some localised flooding, especially across some western higher ground. However, mostly dry, warm and bright further south, especially across south Wales, southern and southwestern England, but still quite windy here.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Remaining breezy and rather cloudy with rain or showers for most areas, but the heavy rain easing somewhat in central parts. Northeast Scotland will perhaps remain mostly dry and bright, but rather cool. Occasional misty conditions will plague some western parts with hill fog at times.
