

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Wintry showers will affect eastern areas of England and parts of Northern Ireland and northern Scotland, with these continuing overnight, giving some further slight accumulations in places. Elsewhere, it will be mainly dry with freezing fog and low cloud slowly clearing, giving increasing amounts of sunshine this afternoon. Feeling very cold with freshening northerly winds. A widespread frost developing tonight.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Dry and mainly sunny in southern parts of the UK on Thursday but cloudier elsewhere, with outbreaks of light rain or sleet, giving a risk of ice. These cloudier conditions spreading southwards by Friday with it becoming much less cold.
