

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain across Scotland and Northern Ireland will spread slowly southeastwards reaching parts of Wales and northern England by this evening. To the southeast it will be a cloudy start but it should brighten up, as it should across northwestern parts later. Overnight, rain will continue southeast, although parts of central and southeast England may stay dry.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Outbreaks of rain will clear from England and Wales through Saturday, with cooler, brighter but showery weather spreading from the north and west. This mix of sunshine and showers will continue on Sunday, although the showers will become increasingly confined to eastern parts.
