Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Warm again with mainly sunny skies, but a bit more cloud in places by afternoon with a risk of an isolated heavy shower developing, most likely in the west, although most places will stay dry. It will stay much cooler with an onshore breeze along the east coast.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Dry for eastern parts with some sunshine and little cloud. Warm inland, cooler on the east coast. Cloud with outbreaks of showery rain coming into the southwest tomorrow afternoon and edging slowly Northeast to give a cloudy day with outbreaks of rain in the west on Friday.
