Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Rain gradually clearing eastwards, although some eastern coasts could remain cloudy. Drier weather will follow from the west across many parts, giving sunny spells and a few showers. Further west, a band of showery rain, perhaps thundery, will affect Northern Ireland and southwest England this morning, reaching other western parts later. Brisk winds in places, especially the southwest, will make it feel cold.

Becoming mainly dry overnight with patchy mist, fog and frost. Rain will reach southwestern areas later.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:  
Generally cloudy and rather windy on both Thursday and Friday with outbreaks of rain. Brighter in northern areas with some showers.
