

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Tuesday 07 Dec 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Outbreaks of snow in northern England and northwest Wales will gradually ease through the afternoon, with snow showers affecting some northern coasts too. Elsewhere, it will be mainly dry, with freezing fog slowly lifting in most places to give some sunshine. Very cold tonight with a widespread severe frost and patchy freezing fog reforming.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:  
Dry with long periods of sunshine in many places on Wednesday, after freezing fog patches clear. However, it will be cloudier in some eastern parts, with wintry showers affecting some eastern coasts. It will start to turn slightly less cold on Thursday, but with more cloud.
