Headline:

Sunny spells but heavy, squally showers. Drier in east tonight.

Today:

Some sunny spells but frequent heavy and squally showers, with a risk of thunder. Generally windy, perhaps gales in places. Feeling chilly in the wind.

Tonight:

Showers becoming mostly confined to the northwest, with clear spells for a time elsewhere.

Outlook for Sunday:

Persistent, heavy rain spreading up from the southwest to affect most areas. Windy with gales in the exposed south and west.
