Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A mostly dry and bright day for many across Scotland, Northern Ireland and western parts of the UK. Further snow showers are likely for eastern England, a few spreading southwestwards during the evening and overnight. Clear spells are likely to last across far western parts of the UK overnight. Very cold with a continued risk of frost and ice.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:  
Bright spells across western parts of the UK, with snow showers continuing mostly across eastern areas on Saturday. More persistent snow is expected across the South on Sunday, with drier and brighter weather in the North. Cold with strong southeasterly winds.
