

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Thursday 29 Jul 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most places fine and dry with variable, and at times large, amounts of cloud, but some good bright or sunny spells too. Scattered showers are likely in eastern England and Scotland but should stay light or moderate. Overnight, remaining dry with clear periods, but cloud and rain spreading to Northern Ireland and western Scotland by dawn.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Rain will continue to spread eastwards to much of the UK during Friday, though southeastern areas are likely to stay dry until Friday night. On Saturday, rain lingering in southeast England through the morning, but drier with sunny spells and scattered showers elsewhere.
