Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Many places will start dull and grey. However, mist and low cloud should lift from most places, and then there will be long spells of sunshine. Areas near North Sea coasts, may remain rather dull for much of the day. It will feel warm in sunshine and in light winds.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Little change on Saturday, dry with plenty of sunshine once mist and low cloud clears and it will again be warm. A big change on Sunday as outbreaks of rain are expected to spread southeastwards on brisk southwesterly winds, and for most, it will turn much cooler than of late.
