Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 1800 UTC Sunday 01 November to 1800 UTC Monday 02 November 2015

#### General Situation

High pressure will tend to dominate the weather for the next couple of days, bringing light winds in many areas, but also some slow-moving dense fog at times, especially overnight and during the mornings in coastal areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 until later, decreasing 4 at times later.  
Rough in north, slight or moderate in south.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Moderate or rough in north, slight or moderate in south.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate near Rattray Head.

Mainly fair.

Moderate, occasionally poor in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first near Rattray Head, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight, occasionally moderate near Rattray Head.

Fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly southerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north.

Slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 for a time, but mainly south 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches, showers later in south.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming south 3 or 4.

Slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 for a time, but mainly south 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches, showers later.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Variable, 3 or less, becoming southeasterly 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches, showers later.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southeasterly 4 or 5.

Slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 4 or 5.

Slight.

Showers later.

Moderate or poor, becoming mostly good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

East 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight.

Showers later.

Moderate or poor, becoming mostly good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches in east for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in east for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later in far west.

Showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west.

Fog patches, mainly in Bristol Channel.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in Bristol Channel.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later near Lands End.

Showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times later.

Slight, occasionally moderate in south.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast, 3 or 4 occasionally 5 or 6 near St Davids Head.

Slight, occasionally moderate in far south.

Fog patches at first, then mainly fair.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming mostly good later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

South 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming mostly good later.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

South 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast, 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming mostly good later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 for a time in north.

Slight, occasionally moderate in north.

Fog patches for a time, occasional drizzle later in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 4 or 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate in north.

Occasional drizzle.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good later.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate near Mull of Kintyre.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly backing southeasterly later, 4 or 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate near Mull of Kintyre.  
Fog patches at first in south, occasional drizzle later.  
Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor at first in south.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.  
Moderate or rough.  
Occasional drizzle later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in south.  
Occasional drizzle.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South or southwest 5 to 7.  
Moderate or rough.  
Mainly fair, occasional drizzle in far northwest.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times later.  
Moderate or rough.  
Drizzle at times.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in north.  
Rough or very rough.  
Mainly fair, occasional drizzle in far northwest.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times later.  
Rough, becoming moderate.  
Drizzle at times.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland  
Valid Sunday 01 Nov 2015 at 1800 UTC until Monday 02 Nov 2015 at 0600 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation  
Pressure remains high over the North Sea. A low will move northeast over Iceland.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Southwesterly gale force 8.

Southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in far northwest.  
Rough or very rough, but moderate just east of Shetland.  
Rain at times.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Monday 02 Nov until 1800 UTC on Monday 02 Nov:  
Southwest 5 to 7 backing south 4 or 5.

Rough or very rough, but moderate just east of Shetland.  
Mainly fair, fog patches later in south.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later in south.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Southeast to east 2 to 3, occasionally 4, increasing 4 during the afternoon,  
perhaps locally 5 mid-channel.

Slight.

Fine.

Good, locally moderate around dawn.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast to east 4 to 5, increasing 5 to 6 at times.

Slight increasing moderate in the north and west by dawn, with a low swell.

Isolated showers Tuesday morning.

Good, locally moderate in showers.

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
