Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A largely cloudy day across the north and east of the UK, although mostly dry. The south and west will see more spells of sunshine, with temperatures higher than recent days. Outbreaks of rain and blustery winds will spread into Scotland and Northern Ireland through the evening, and into northwest England overnight. Dry overnight elsewhere.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Cloudy, with occasional rain or drizzle across northwestern parts of the UK on Friday. It will remain dry elsewhere, with warm sunny spells. Through Saturday, cloud and rain will spread south, with brighter weather moving into the north. Southeast England, however should stay dry.
