Headline:

Mostly cloudy. Patchy rain moving southeast, heavier later. Mild.

Today:

England/Wales cloudy, spots of rain, drizzle and hill fog in west with freshening winds. Scotland/N.Ireland cloudy with rain, becoming drier from northwest.

Tonight:

Rain becoming more widespread and heavy at times in England/Wales. Rain clearing N.Isles, then Scotland and N.Ireland mostly dry before blustery showers reach western and northern regions later.

Outlook for Tuesday:

Rain clearing England/Wales. Blustery showers in northwest easing. Feeling colder.
