

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Sunday 04 Nov 2007

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Western and northern Scotland, cloudy with rain or drizzle. Elsewhere, patchy fog clearing slowly, but lingering well into the day in places. Otherwise, dry with some bright or sunny intervals. Tonight, rain will spread south across Scotland and Northern Ireland. Elsewhere, remaining dry with patchy fog becoming more widespread.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

A weakening band of rain will edge southwards across England and Wales on Monday with sunnier skies across Scotland following southwards. Tuesday will be mostly dry with sunny intervals, but will turn cloudy and damp in the northwest later. It will feel cooler and fresher in brisk westerly winds.
