

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Friday 10 Jul 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It'll be sunny and very warm in the south. Meanwhile rain, locally heavy, will affect parts of Scotland and Northern Ireland. There is also the risk of some thundery showers developing across northern England and southeastern Scotland later on. Overnight bands of showery rain will move eastwards across the north whilst it should stay mostly dry in the south.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Rain in the north will quickly clear on Saturday with showers following. It'll be drier and very warm in the south and east, before rain arrives from the southwest. Sunday will then see rain in the south and showers further north.
