Forecast for the UK.

at 0700 on Monday 7 November 2005

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Scattered showers will die out from all apart from northwest
Scotland, then most places will be dry and quite sunny for a time.
However, cloud and heavy rain will spread to northern and many
western areas this afternoon accompanied by gale force southerly
winds.

Tonight, Heavy rain across Northern Ireland and Scotland will clear
to leave squally showers with winds increasing to severe gale force,
with perhaps a violent storm for a time for northwest Scotland.
Northern England and Wales will be cloudy and very wet, whilst the
rest of England remains mostly dry, but windy.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Remaining very unsettled and windy with further heavy rain or showers
for all areas.
