Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Scotland, Northern Ireland and Northern England mostly cloudy with showers and some longer spells of rain though conditions will improve over Northern Ireland this afternoon. Wales and the rest of England, sunny spells with a few showers mainly over west. Windy especially over the north. Generally mild, very mild over the south.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Generally fine for many parts on Monday with some brightness but rain and drizzle will affect Wales and Southern England. Warm in any sunshine with light winds. Rain spreads to most parts on Tuesday, heavy in the west where it will become quite breezy with extensive hill fog.
