

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Monday 05 Aug 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Very wet across western England, Wales and southern Scotland bringing a risk of flooding, with strong winds in the south. Rain moving slowly northeastwards with brighter conditions following. A few showers in the far north and southeast, but brighter here. Overnight, mostly dry with some localised mist patches forming. Cloudier in the northwest with a few showers. Feeling fresher.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday, many places dry and bright with sunny spells and feeling warm in the sunshine with lighter winds than recently. A few showers possible to the north and west. A higher chance of showers on Wednesday, perhaps heavy and slow moving.
