Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
There will be plenty of fine and dry weather for many, with warm sunny spells and light winds. However, there may be a few isolated showers in places, these will be heaviest and most frequent across parts of northern Scotland.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Unseasonably windy, with gales in the far northwest, with heavy and persistent rain. Mostly fine and dry, with warm sunny spells across England and Wales. Becoming rather humid overnight. Staying unsettled and windy across northern parts on Sunday, gales slowly easing. Mainly dry, bright and breezy in the south, where still warm.
